Cool it. I'm the Queen! That's Har Har in my dress!

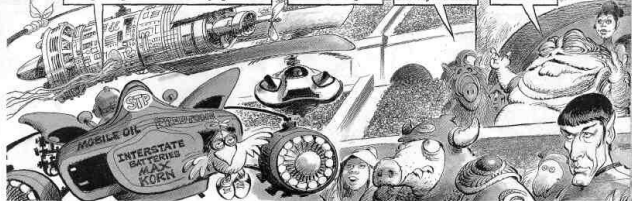


Watching me race my pod is pretty exciting, unless you happened to see *Return of the Jedi*, which had a much more exciting race through the giant redwoods on flying scooters!
